Toilets – Locked most of the time and they look awful. Cllr Swift stated that this is a NNDC responsibility but we have wrote to them and spoken to them about this issue.

New planted trees – Question regarding who will take responsibility for maintenance. Cllr Swift stated that this is the responsibility of NNDC. Cllr Swift to look into the issue with the maintenance being temporary contracts. Cllr Swift stated that two new trees will be planted within the churchyard and another somewhere in the village for the Jubilee.

Parking in VH car park – Asked whether any parking could be used in the VH car park for the village store etc. Cllr Swift stated that this had been looked into before and it has not been allowed by the WVHMC.
